MODEL RELATED REPORTABLE INCIDENTS

Depending on the severity and appropriate need for the action members on-scene should assist with one or more of the following tasks

1. **If any emergency service is required, DIAL 999.**
2. **Attend to casualty/s** (including those suffering from SHOCK)
3. **Take photos** of everything relevant, inc. injuries and cars on site.
4. **It is also vitally important** to record date, time, who, what and every detail of the incident no matter how trivial, (ideally use the club incident form). Everyone involved and all witnesses should also write their account at the earliest opportunity, while still fresh in your mind. This is for understanding, for the benefit of prevention **not** blame.
5. **Reportable incident to the BMFA** @ <https://reporting.bmfa.uk/> or phone **01162 440028** include: minor injury; loss of control endangering others or property; fly away where model isn't found.

6. **A MODEL RELATED FATALITY, SERIOUS INJURY or FULL-SIZE AIRCRAFT INCIDENT MUST be reported as soon as possible to the BMFA and**
